Dear Friends of Walter Reed Army Medical Center (WRAMC),

The Walter Reed Society is sponsoring a reunion in the Rose Garden on the old WRAMC property on Sunday, October 4, 2020, 1:00 – 4:00 PM.

The reunion is expected to draw 250 attendees. We are making every effort to encourage anyone with a Walter Reed connection - the medical center, Walter Reed Army Institute of Research, Armed Forces Institute of Pathology, support units and activities - to attend. This includes former patients, commanders, physicians, nurses, ancillary staff, researchers, vendors, house keepers, maintenance personnel, grounds keepers, neighbors, friends, supporter – military and civilian. Come one and all, reconnect with special people – old friends and colleagues – to recall your experiences at this special place.

Many changes have been made since installation closure in 2011. Heaton Pavilion has been torn down, Delano Hall has been converted to a DC international school, and a portion of Abrams Hall provides homeless veterans' and senior housing. There will be significant ongoing construction and some portions of the campus will be off limits.
